CHIMNEYTREE is now on view--indefinitely--in
Manhattan.

A live, growing tree rises from the top of a 70 foot
chimney at W. 30th and 11th Avenue. Planted in May,
1990, it is the third CHIMNEYTREE to be created
as part of a series of environmental artworks.

The juxtaposition of the ancient symbol for life
held aloft by the humanmade carrier of pollution
reminds us of the alienation that has developed
between humans and their planet.

CHIMNEYTREE's creation is intended to portray
that clear and dangerous estrangement; inspire
a reaffirmation of humankind's link with the
earth's resources; and remain a visible symbol
of hope on the urban landscape.
